Koldwave King Kompac

The Koldwave King Kompac is a portable windowless cooling unit available for rent during emergencies and construction. The water-cooled operation requires no outside air, so you are guaranteed peak energy efficiency even on the hottest days. The unit just needs to be connected to a water supply and a drain. An automatic water-regulating valve shuts off the water flow when the compressor is not running to help ensure maximum efficiency and performance. The King Kompac models provides 23,000 BTU/HR of cooling capacity, electric temperature controls can be adjusted using the up and down arrows on a touch pad, a 2-speed fan, recovery mode for power interruptions, and quiet operation.

10-ton Portable Carrier Heating & Cooling Unit for Rent

We have 10-ton Carrier natural gas heating and electric cooling unit on a trailer for rent, that can be brought to you. It is environmentally designed unit consumes less fossil fuels which results in a reduction of greenhouse gases. The control system is readily adaptable to all conventional and programmable thermostats. In addition, the unit can be integrated into monitor control systems if required. It has sloped condensate pans that eliminate possible biological growth and a face-split indoor coil design that removes additional moisture from the air. It recirculates with minimal outside air intake and is completely adjustable.
